A Christocentric Economy (Christonomy) is an economic system that is built on the principles of the agape love of Christ and the wisdom of God, for the shared benefit of all creation and with eternity in view. It is an economic system in which the agape love of Christ and the wisdom of God is in full control and operates the hearts of His sons; with the intention of restoring and establishing the original purpose of the Creator for the universe.

Christonomy is built on the following biblical foundations:

- God created all things in Christ, He owns everything, and He entrusted us humans, made in His likeness and image, to be good stewards over his creation through work as it was commanded to the first man.
- Every man has a personal wealth to develop, a garden to work and a river to ride.
- Government as an organized system of leadership is ordained by God for the purpose of order to create an enabling environment for a peaceful, progressive and productive coexistence of humanity and other God's creation. (Romans 13:1).
- Work is a privilege and an obligation of every human being. He who does not work let him not eat, says the Holy Book. Working in the original program of God does not necessarily mean suffering but developing and growing one's personal wealth.
- No one came to the earth empty; everyone is born with something to develop (a value to develop and sell to the world).
- The earth was cursed at the fall of man and that affected the economy of the earth. As a result of this, the land was reduced to bringing thorns and thistles and the mind of the operators of the economy became twisted and got filled with wickedness, greed, envy and lust.
- Though humanity had lost the blessing after the fall, the curse upon the earth was destroyed by the finished work of Christ and humanity now has the freedom to return to the blessing.
- To enjoy the fullness of the blessing of God, the universe and all that are in it must return to Christ and be submissive to Him. The practice of Christonomy therefore should be a tool for disciplining the nations for Christ.
- Any prosperity outside Christ is prosperity in crisis. It is possible to be rich and be lost.

This type of love is not human but divine, it is the God kind of love, it is not self-seeking. The first man lived in that love until his fall. In that love is genuine passion that serves as the compass for finding and fulfilling purpose. When man fell, that love was replaced with lust and greed, thus making it very difficult for men to live the life of love, passion and purpose.

TOP PRIORITY

My pastor says that every man has the freedom to choose but you are not given the freedom to choose the consequences of your choice. According to Robert West, in his book “how to study the bible”, Mary the worshipper wants her soul fed by Jesus- her sister Martha, the worker, wants to feed Jesus. I want you to note that the thing that got Martha to be in the kitchen cooking and Mary sitting at the foot of the master is Priority. Priority according to dictionary.com means “the right to take precedence over others or something given special attention to others. Each of us has the power, the right to choose what will come first in our life. This right is given to you. The right to choose what matters most in your life has been given to you. In economics, it is called the scale of preference. You use scale of preference to know your most needed things to your least wanted things and to get your priority aright and to achieve your unsatisfied with your limited resources.

Know your most needed thing.

The life of a woman is a busy one whether as a single woman, married, divorced or widow. She needs to be well coordinated to go through life fulfilling purpose. To do this, you need to put your responsibilities in a list form. From our definition above, know your most needed thing. At any given time, know your most needed thing. Why? So you can focus on it first. Your most needed thing is that thing you cannot do without. This is the truth Jesus was teaching through the lives of these two sisters Mary and Martha in (Luke 10:38-42). Jesus said to Martha at this time, at this moment “there is only one thing worth being concerned about” (NLT). There is one thing worth taking your attention. As women, we try to worry about everything, we concern ourselves with everything; we even connect everything. A lot of things are striving for our attention: cooking, children, sisters, husbands, brothers, cosmetics, finances, relations, in-laws, hairdos, church service, God, Satan etc.

When all these are seeking for your attention what should you do? Mary has discovered it. Discover

It. Discover the most important thing in your life. That thing that you cannot do without. Then ask yourself, which of these things striving for my attention is really worth my time now or is most needed. Mary was able to discover that sitting at the foot of Jesus was the most need thing in her life at that moment. She consciously forgo running around, setting tables, cooking, visiting friends, watching movies, going to the gym, making her hair, buying new makeup kit, etc. She carefully told all the other things seeking her attention “sorry guys the master of my soul is here and He is the most important thing in my life, all of you can wait, so I am going to be with him now. See you guys later. She did not only discover it, she chose it. In this case, your most needed thing is spending quality & intimate time with God. Your relationship with God is what matters most. At every given time your relationship with God should come first because that is what will help you handle other things that come up in your list. Discover your most needed thing and do that first and others will perfectly follow.

Other wanted things

Your other wanted things are things you can still do after you have done the most needed thing. Mary deeply understood that spending time with God first is the only thing that will give her the grace to do the other

things on her priority list. You cannot face other things seeking your attention well without a quality moment with the most important relationship on earth. Your least wanted things can wait but your most needed thing cannot wait.

Only one thing is needful, that is your relationship with God, your time with God, your sitting at his feet. The one thing needful is your source of strength and power to do the other things. It's a choice which no one will make for you but you and you alone have to make. Martha's choice was to feed Jesus, Mary's choice was to be fed by Jesus. No man can feed Jesus well until you have been fed by him. Martha would have done a better guest service ministry if she first allowed the master to feed her. You cannot love your



Introduction to Income Tax for Individuals

Many of us get rattled when we hear income tax and we see the Tax man as this terrible man

who wants to take our earnings and leave us poor. In South Africa, we use the Progressive Tax System, meaning the less you earn, the less tax you pay and vice versa. Tax payers are crucial to the economy of the Republic. Most of the income that the State needs in order to function is commonly derived from personal and corporate income taxes. Although a quarter of it comes from indirect taxes (VAT) the burden to recover monies is based on businesses and individuals. Not all income earned is subject to tax.

Who needs to pay tax?

All individuals who are earning an income need to be registered tax payers. Being a registered tax payer does not equate to you paying over tax from income or salary earned. This allows SARS to know how many people are in the labour force. This information is gathered when employers submit the information over to South African Revenue Services (SARS) and in turn individuals receive a tax certificate named IRP5. At the

end of May each year employers are liable to send in salary information to SARS. At the end of the process every individual is entitled to an IRP5: should you not receive one from your employers, request for one. In the financial year ending 28 February 2019, all individuals who have earned less than R78 150.00 p.a (R 6 512,5 monthly) are not liable to pay any income tax. Income that exceeds the above threshold are subject to tax and that is dependent on the gross income received and the tax bracket in which you fall under.


to pay tax over to SARS. To salaried individuals, the employer is liable

to give you a payslip that clearly states your gross income and what deductions are applicable. That is when you will pick up if they are deducting tax if applicable or not. If they have deducted it from your earnings then it becomes their obligation to pay it to the revenue services. Referring back to what was said earlier, it is your constitutional right to request an IRP5 from your employer. This will put you at ease knowing that they have relayed your financial information over to the revenue services. When the tax season opens, your IRP5 would be instrumental in submitting your ITR12 (Income Tax Return for individuals). Salaried employees earning a gross less than R350 000 p. a are not subjected to submit Income Tax returns when the tax season opens.

Who is subjected to submit Tax Returns?

Individuals earning income from more than one source including rental income, interest bearing investments etc.

- Individuals earning more than R350 000.
- Individuals earning less than R350 000 and have deductible expenses not reflected on IRP5
- Business owners



The information shared above mostly applies to salaried employees, but business owners are also subject to submitting their personal taxes. This is where most small business owners get a little confused. One needs to keep in mind a registered business operates separately to the individual. Yes, it is your business but legally it is an entity on its own right. We mostly advise business owners to draw a personal salary that is a deductible expense for the company's taxes. In principle, you pay yourself a salary for the service you have provided for the business. When drawing a salary you

will be paying your taxes over to SARS on a monthly basis which requires you to register for PAYE (Pay As You Earn). Which is a necessity if you have other people working for you. If you are not drawing a salary then your personal expenditure drawn from the business account will form your income. For those running a business as themselves, meaning it is not a legally registered, a sole proprietor or a partnership need to keep a proper record of what is business expenditure and what is personal. When filling your income tax return you will declare your revenue less business related expenditure and your taxable income

would be the profit made which will still be subject to the tax tables shared above. In short your taxable income will be the profit made from business dealings. Be encouraged to take your tax affairs seriously. The 1st step is to register yourself as a tax payer, if you are not sure if you are registered or not call SARS and confirm with them or visit any of their branches. Complying with the tax laws is a noble thing, tax evasion is a serious criminal offense!

so VAT has increased to 15% what does that mean for the citizens?

Value Added Tax has been levied at 14 % for the past 25 years. However, due to the revenue shortfall and the R48 billion in the fiscus, the state has set mechanisms to recover this short fall and unfortunately Value Added Tax amongst other taxes had to be victim. However, what does this increase mean for the citizens of South Africa?

Many staple food items such as bread, milk, fresh fruits and vegetables and certain tinned food are subject to VAT at zero percent, which actually means that there is no vat levied on those items. When our Minister of finance made this announcement, many households were worried how they would survive increased food prices due to inflation and how the

'supposed' VAT increase would affect their standard of living. Practically speaking many households consume products and live off many items that are outside the zero-rate list. Many toiletry items that form a need in households such as soap and sanitary towels have not been enlisted. These are essential items that form part of human dignity but with all this price fixing and VAT hikes, how is the government helping communities and also striking a balance in recovering revenue necessary for the needs of the country?

To alleviate the burden, the Minister of Finance announced that there would be an increase in social grants by allocating R2.6 billion to cover the extra cost of VAT. According to economic research assessing the impact of the VAT increase in this

way does not entirely fix the problem because the low income households spend most of their income on these indirect taxes. The Davis Committee recommended that "While there would be a negative impact on real Gross Domestic Product and employment, particularly in the short term, the impact of a VAT increase on these two variables [GDP and employment] would be less severe than that of a rise in [personal income tax] or [corporate income tax]."

As an expert in the field I sympathise with the low income households and also in agreement with the government with the VAT increase because the main contributors to state revenue are taxpayers and pushing them into higher tax brackets by increasing the marginal tax rate would create another nightmare.

Nevertheless, all hope is not lost for our developing economy, let us continue to work together by paying our taxes.

WHO OFFERS REGIONAL SUPPORT IN LISTERIOSIS CRISIS

The possibility of listeriosis spreading beyond South Africa's borders has prompted the World Health Organisation (WHO) to offer preparedness and response support to 16 African nations.

Nearly 200 South Africans have died since January 2017 from eating contaminated processed meat products, which may also have been exported to two West African countries and 14 members of the South African Development Community (Sadc).

The South African National Department of Health traced the source of the outbreak to Tiger Brands' Enterprise factory in Polokwane, which prompted a national and international recall of the food products. However, in light of the

potentially long incubation period of listeriosis and the challenges relating to large scale nationwide recall processes, further cases are likely to occur. Namibia has reported one confirmed case of listeriosis, a man who was admitted to hospital in early March. An investigation is ongoing to determine whether the case is connected to the outbreak in South Africa.

Awareness

WHO's health emergencies programme, the Global Outbreak Alert and Response Network (GOARN) and the International Food Safety Authorities Network (INFOSAN) are working with the 16 priority countries - Angola, Botswana, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Ghana, Lesotho, Madagascar, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Nigeria, Swaziland, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe - to improve their ability to prepare for, detect and respond to potential outbreaks.

Immediate steps will include increasing awareness on listeriosis, enhancing active surveillance and laboratory diagnosis, ensuring readiness of rapid response teams, and

strengthening coordination and contingency planning. Experts have been deployed to South Africa, Lesotho and Swaziland to support these efforts.

The link between the contaminated products, the producing company and strains of listeria isolated from the patients was made by the use of whole genome sequencing of isolated strains of the listeria bacteria. WHO is supporting further genome sequencing to determine which cases are linked to this on-going outbreak. In March, South Africa hosted a meeting of Sadc health ministers to address regional preparedness and response to listeriosis. Ministers committed to regional collaboration, exchanging information and strengthening national food safety systems in line with international standards.

WHO does not currently recommend any trade related measures in relation to the current outbreak of listeriosis in South Africa, other than the recall of products identified as sources of infection.

HERE'S WHAT HAPPENS TO YOUR BODY IF YOU EAT TOO MUCH SALT

Salt does more than just make your food taste more delicious—it's important for your body to function properly. Sodium, one of the key ingredients in table salt, regulates blood flow and pressure, and helps transmit messages between nerves and muscle fibers. Chloride, the other chemical in table salt, aids in digestion.

Foods in your diet need to have enough salt replenish these nutrients to keep you healthy. But too much salt can be bad for you.

Processed foods are packed with the stuff; restaurants add more salt to their food to make it taste better. As a result, more people are eating high-sodium diets (sometimes without even knowing it), which has some pretty drastic effects on their health.

When you consume too much sodium in your diet, your body holds extra water. That's because the kidneys, which filter out waste from the blood, maintain a special ratio of electrolytes, such as sodium to potassium, to water. More salt in the diet means the kidneys keep more water in the system. That can have lots of undesirable effects, such as Edema (swelling in places like the hands, arms, feet, ankles, and legs); more fluid in general means more blood coursing through veins and arteries. Over time, that causes them to stiffen, which could lead to high blood pressure.

Over time...it could lead to high blood pressure. You probably already know that salt can make you thirsty—that's the body's way of trying to correct that sodium-water ratio. Drinking lots of water can exacerbate issues of edema and blood pressure. But not drinking enough could force the body to draw water out of other cells, making you dehydrated. People who consume high-sodium diets usually urinate more because of all the excess water. Every time you urinate, your body loses calcium, the mineral that, among other things, makes strong bones and teeth; urinate too often and the body could lose too much calcium, weakening bones and exacerbating osteoporosis.

Then there are the effects that no one quite understands. Some studies have found that excess salt brings on stomach ulcers, infections, and may even hasten stomach cancer.

No one is quite sure why, but some researchers suspect that the sodium may disrupt the stomach's mucus lining, according to Live Strong.

Salt can negatively impact your cognitive function, too, according to a 2010 study. That study was purely observational, so the researchers don't hypothesize why that might be happening. The evidence is clear: Too much salt can have serious long-term health implications. But lots of people eat diets in which the sodium intake far exceeds the daily-recommended value of 2,300 milligrams.

Hopefully, as a result of this information, more people can be more aware of the salt they consume, adjust their diets accordingly, and be healthier as a result. As for everyone else: it probably wouldn't hurt to pay closer attention to your salt intake.



Having been in the financial services industry for the last 14 years, I have noted with interest that there is a direct link between financial literacy and wealth creation. Financial literacy is one's ability to process economic information and make informed decisions about

If you learn to budget wisely and manage your finances responsibly, you will have peace of mind at the end of each month. Not only does it ensure you always have enough money for the things you need and want, it can also help to keep you out of debt (or if already in debt – to work yourself out of it).


The more we borrow, the more interest we pay and the less disposable income we have. Debt is often accompanied by worry and stress and can lead to marital problems, hopelessness about the future and other life issues. So, before you take any debt, it is crucial to study your budget to determine if you can afford to take it and satisfy yourself that the purchase is absolutely necessary.

You won't have to borrow to fund your purchases if you save for your needs and those things you want. Of course, deciding to save always means giving up on things you'd want to buy today to fund the things you want to be able to afford in the future (known as delayed gratification). In other words, it means sacrificing today and think carefully about what you are prepared to do without today to meet your future financial goals. This includes and is not limited to saving for emergencies (to cover basic living expenses in the event of loss of income), saving for retirement (to ensure that you maintain a comfortable standard of living when you retire) and other goals; such as buying your home etc. The choice about where to invest your money is between you and your financial planner and always based on your goals, your risk tolerance, and the period for which you want to invest; which can be split among different options.

Estate planning is an essential part of financial planning. It is a means of ensuring that your wealth and assets are efficiently distributed to the people you want to inherit them. It ensures that you are well covered for any estate liquidity shortfalls, and that your instructions are carried out well when the time comes i.e. gathering of your assets, paying off any debts before distributing remaining assets to the beneficiaries, dealing with third parties such as government, insurance companies, etc. to ensure that your affairs are handled as you wish.






